Key purpose: The Test Analyst focuses on testing the software in the product to determine product quality and ensure that the delivered product matches the requirements for the project.

The Test Analyst is expected to autonomously writing test cases, performing manual testing and scripting automated tests. These tests will prove that the product matches the requirements of the market and be able to be used on an ongoing basis.

Analysing anomalies and documenting them in a reproducible manner to assist in their prioritisation by management and to aid developers in fixing them is also a key component of the role.
